The cruise will return to Sydney at 0700 hours on the 2nd of May. The bus will be available to take members from the terminus back to the hotel.

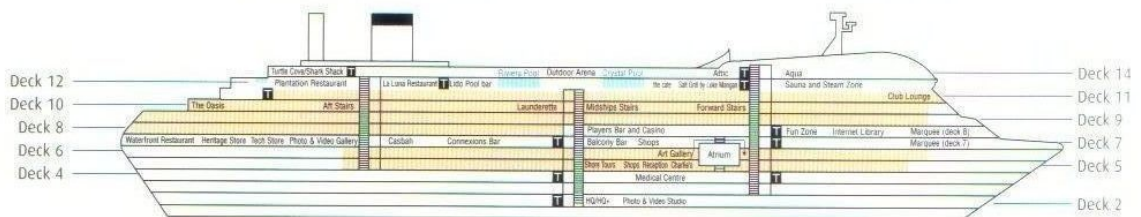
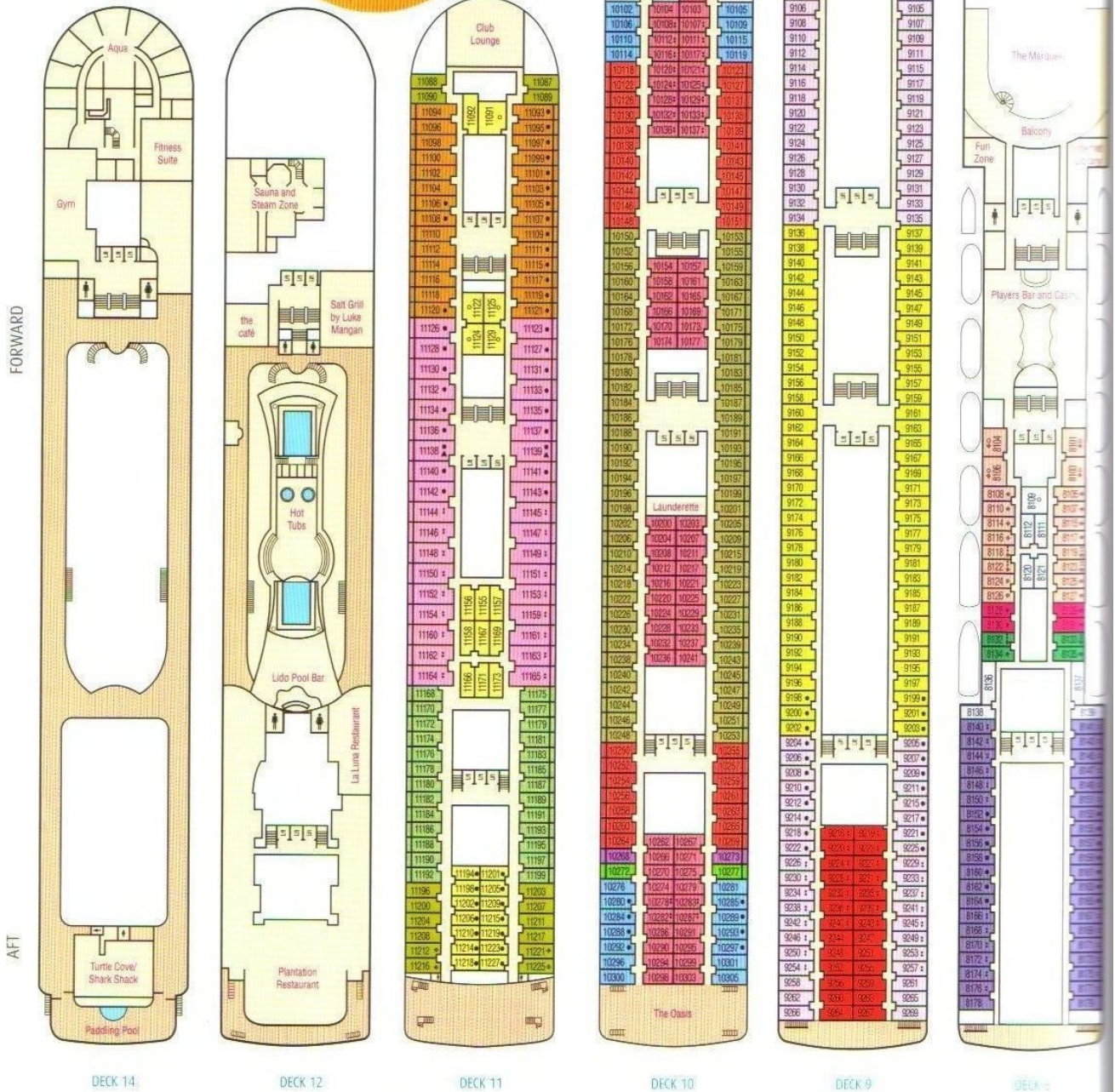

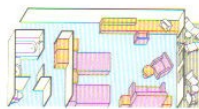

Mini-Suite with Balcony (approx 34m²)



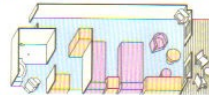

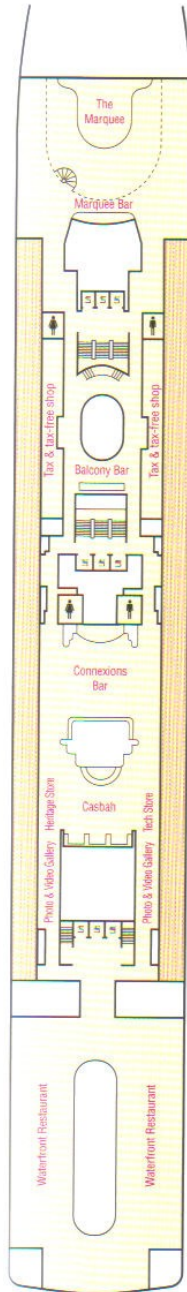
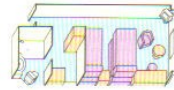


Outside or Inside 3- or 4- berth (approx 17.3m²)

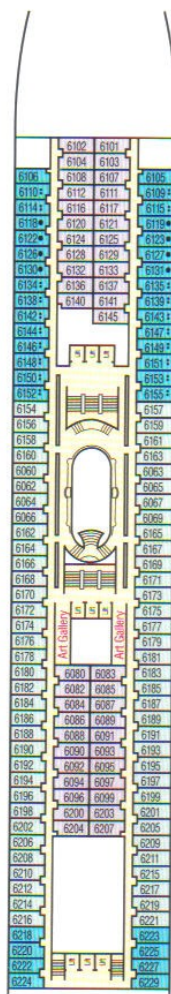


- Two lower beds and two upper beds or a chair bed

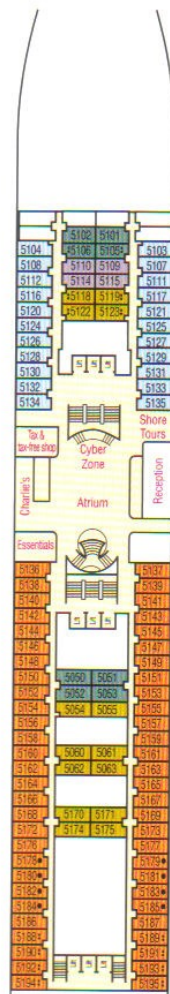
Note: Twin beds cannot be converted to a queen-size bed if the 3rd or 4th upper berths are occupied.



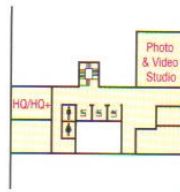

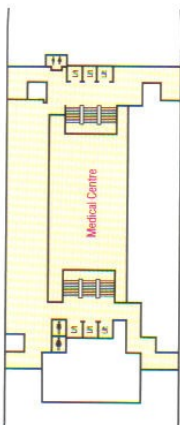
